#### **Sanctuary Remodel**

I would like to inform every one of the Sanctuary remodel progress. There will be work going on from time to time on different areas to ensure that we get things done in a timely manner. We do not want anyone to think we are not having Sunday services because of construction. The goal is to have services in the Sanctuary every Sunday until we remove the pews and replace with chairs. When that happens, we may miss one Sunday in the Sanctuary. Services would be moved to Fellowship Hall for that Sunday if needed.

The next noticeable change will begin April 3<sup>rd.</sup> The Sacristy area will be getting a makeover. The two storage area doors in the front will be filled in and the Lecterns as they are now, will be removed. There will be temporary furniture replacing what we take out, so we will continue to hold services as usual.

The chairs and floor coverings have been ordered. The project team will be researching some new pieces of furniture to replace what we will take out of the Sacristy area.

Be sure to come every Sunday and check out the changes as they occur. The construction may not be glamorous, but the Sanctuary will continue to be functional. I am confident it will look nice and be comfortable and inviting when it is finished. Thank you in advance for your patience with the disruptions while we work through it together.

Trustees are also planning to clean out all the extra items in the Fellowship Hall storage area. This effort will be done along with the Sanctuary remodel. There are pieces of furniture and many other items that are no longer useful in the Church. Trustees would like to offer them free of charge to anyone who may want them. Items that are left when we finish up the remodel will be offered to non-profits. After that the unwanted items will be disposed of.


